My name is Brittany McVey and I am seventeen years old. As far back as I can remember I have always had a love for animals, especially horses. I used to ask for a horse for my birthday every year, and although it never happened until I turned 14, I just kept on wishing. My birthday is on August 25 and for my eighteenth birthday, I plan to not only get a new horse for my birthday, I plan to rescue five of them from an auction where the most predictable outcome is slaughter.

Even though the meat is not sold or eaten by Americans, it is processed here and sent to foreign countries, such as Belgium, France, Germany, and Italy. The most attended auction is in New Holland, PA., where between 200 and 350 horses are auctioned there every Monday. America's horse has carried us into battle, protected us from blinding snow and raging rivers (and??). America's horse as taken us from New England to Utah, and never asked us why. The Indians of the early settlements protected and worshipped their horses. These animals need protection from foreign meat markets.

The Slaughter issue is now up for vote on the House floor. HR 503. If it passes, we will have a surplus of 80,000 horses per year. What do we do with them? I have a plan and so does the rest of America.

My trip will begin on August 25, 2006, from N Ft Myers, FL and end at New Holland, PA. There I will attend the auction, with a friend of the family who has been working in rescue for over a decade. From there, the horses will receive vaccinations, get their health certificates and their Coggins done. I will then be back on the road, leaving the horses at specific approved Equine Rescues on my way back to Ft. Myers. I need to raise funds in order to purchase these horses. These rescued horses will be rehabbed and re-homed. Excess funds will go back into a fund called "Forget Me Not" fund. This is used to pull horses again. The funding gets recycled. With your donation, a life is saved, time after time, one after another. The horses get the much-needed love and care they deserve and you walk away with a phenomenal feeling of power, that you have saved a life.

Your donation is also worthy of a tax receipt from a nonprofit organization. In conjunction with this rescue project, you will be receiving yours from "Pure Thoughts, Foal rescue". The contact there is Jennifer Swanson. She has been instrumental in helping me put the word out, and supporting this effort, by sponsoring my project.

Stolen Tack

I board my horses in horse country, Miami. Towards the end of July our tack room and other storage trailers were broken into. Only Western Tack was stolen:

Circle Y Pleasure Saddle, dark self tanned leather with brandy color suede seat, never oiled. On the side where you mount there are prominent scratch marks from someone's belt buckle. The horn is rawhide lace with the Circle Y silver mark. The back of the seat is rolled with silver metal.

Textan/Hereford Roping saddle, medium color leather, black suede seat and aluminum stirrups engraved on one side.

New Black Saddle, has some German silver.

4 new working bridles with bits and 5/8" reins were also taken. (3) of the bridles/ reins had never been used. The bits attached were: 6" shank snaffle, snaffle twisted wire D-ring, and (2) correction bits with medium ports and swivel shanks.

Horseback Safaris - Standard one-hour, two-hour, or threehour horseback safaris are available daily. Horseback Safaris can be arranged for riders with varying levels of experience. All guests should be



at least 12 years of age; 10 years of age is an acceptable age with proven riding experience. Guests weighing more than 275 pounds will need to be assessed by our Equestrian Director before they are allowed to take a Horseback Safari. Call-in reservations are recommended in order to assure that we and our horses are ready for you.

A favorite with visitors is our two-night "Crescent J Cattle Drive Weekend Safari," which includes some training in Florida Cowhunter skills of ridin', ropin' and cow cuttin'. (Florida cattlemen weren't "cowboys" because hunting those wild Spanish-descent cattle in Florida's woods and swamps was a man's job, they said.) Choice of campground depends on weather, type of group and recommendation of the riding instructors.

Another favorite is similar, but shorter – an Overnight Trail Ride Safari combined with a next-day "Rawhide Roundup." More time is spent riding the wilderness trails of Forever Florida and learning about nature, less on cowpoke skills.

Corporate Co-workers, Schoolteachers, Professional Club, Flying Clubs, School Groups, Church Groups, Families, Friends, Scout troops or multi-troop Camporees - there are activities and a campground on Forever Florida or the Crescent J Ranch that are just right for a bonding experience. See the Facilities and Events page for more details.

From a small primitive one-troop Scout Camp on the Crescent J that has been used by Girl and Boy Scouts for more than 30 years, we expanded to a remote but up-scale campground 'way back in the wilderness of Forever Florida, then added two campgrounds in between and most recently, a large area "up front" (near the highway) that comfortably holds up to twenty Scout troops for a big Camporee.

Yes, factual articles intended to educate the reader may be published, space permitting, free of charge as long as they do not promote a business. Please cite your sources when submitting an article for publication. Everything Equine reserves the right to edit submissions. If your article promotes a business, then it qualifies as advertisement and business rates would apply.

6. I would like to share something that happened to me. Is there a place for that?

Yes, Horse Tales is a place to share your experiences, poems, drawings and whatever else you would like to share. A good rule of thumb for a proper submission for Horse Tales is to keep it in 1st person. Write using, I, me, we, not he, she or they.

7. What are your office hours?

Office hours? What are those? I have a home office, so my office hours are whenever I am near the phone and/or computer. I am in and out during the day, so if you do not get an answer on the phone, please leave a message. Also, do not be surprised if I pick up the phone on a Sunday afternoon. It is a rare occasion when I am not at the computer late at night, so if you send an email at that time, you probably will get an immediate response.
